



COVID 19- WELL CARE POLICY
EFFECTIVE 3/13/2020- 6/1/2021

Due to the current pandemic situation, Lois Johnson has adopted new procedures for daily admission to the childcare setting. We ask that parents do not enter the building. We will screen your child at the door. Entry will be denied if your child presents with the following:

- Oral or Temporal Temperature of 100.4 degrees F or above
- Signs or symptoms of a respiratory infection, such as a cough, shortness of breath, sore throat, and low-grade fever
- In the previous 14 days has had contact with someone with a confirmed diagnosis of COVID-19; is under investigation for COVID-19; or is ill with a respiratory illness
- In the previous 14 days has travelled internationally to countries OR domestically to states or counties with widespread, sustained community transmission.
- Vomiting:
 - Within the last 24 hours prior to arrival
- Uncontrollable diarrhea:
 - Within the last 24 hours prior to arrival
 - You will be called if your child has an episode while in care
- Untreated pink eye
- Undiagnosed rash.
- Unable to participate in group activities.
- Communicable disease.

Once your child has been approved for care at entry, they must wash their hands following the CDC guidelines.

Should your child become ill at Lois Johnson, we will call you to pick him/her up within 30 minutes of the phone call. Your child will be separated from the other children in care. If you cannot come within the half-hour, you are expected to have another person pick up your child by that time. If we do not hear from you or your child is not picked up within that time, we will call the person indicated on your emergency contact form to come pick up your child.

Your child may return to care after 14 days if symptomatic. Your child may also return to care if a medical verification of a NEGATIVE COVID-19 test, or a letter from their physician stating that they are symptom free and not contagious

If you have a question regarding your child's health and if he/she should come to care, please call the center prior to arrival at Lois Johnson.
